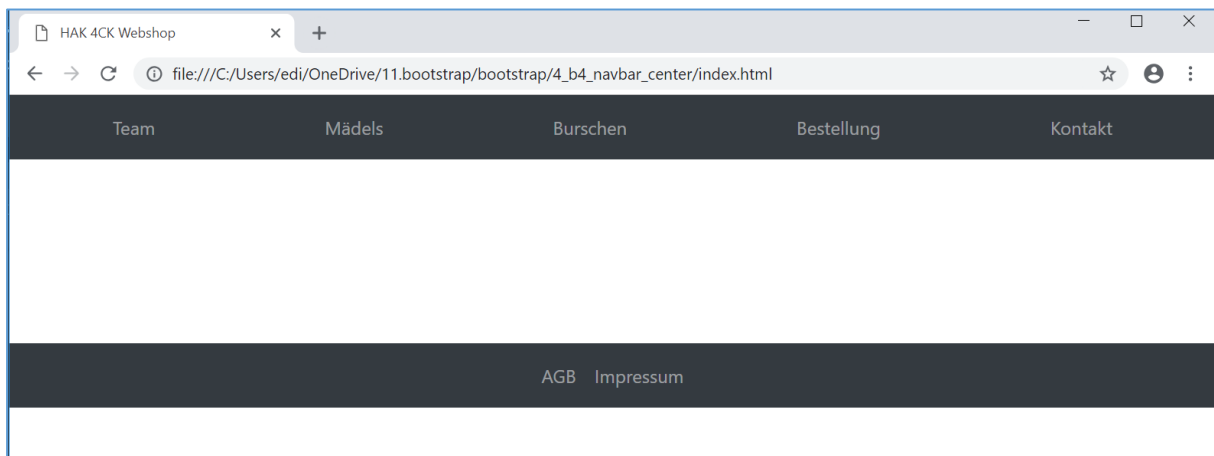


Navbar Elemente zentrieren – 2 Möglichkeiten



1. Oben: mit der Klasse: nav-fill (nav-fill w-100)
Damit werden die Elemente **proportional** aufgeteilt.
In der Navigation darf man aber das „nav-item“ nicht vergessen.
